**Nature Notes.** : On a recent visit to a village in central France, I noticed that almost all the houses had house martins nesting under the deep set eaves. Our houses are not designed like that, although in Slingsby I found five buildings with deep set eaves, under which I counted over twenty, mostly used, nests. In 2006 I counted 12 nests. Dave and Sue Heeley have erected artificial nests on their house, which are being used by house martins. Like swifts and swallows, house martins need some help with their nesting sites.
