**Nature Notes:** In the last Parishes Newsletter I referred to a grey wagtail collecting nesting materials. The nesting site was eventually observed high up in an ivy growing up a gable end of a house opposite to our home. By 15<sup>th</sup> May 2 or three youngsters were fledged. On 30<sup>th</sup> May the pair were collecting more nesting materials and going through a courtship display, but no second nest was found. An unusual, but rare, moth turned up in a moth trap in Slingsby with a common name of 'poplar lutestring' on 3<sup>rd</sup> June. MT 7.6.07. (628620).
