## From the Rectory.

*Dear Friends,*

We continue to think about the future of our parishes in the light of the Deanery Plan. One aspect is the need to collaborate more closely as a Benefice, and to consider the possibility of becoming a single parish. Therefore we propose to share more services together – between the Anglican congregations and also with our Methodist friends. So you will notice that from September we will have more frequent united Benefice services than previously (approximately once a month), and we hope these will be popular and build up a sense of belonging. We hope too that they will have the effect of making the worship more lively and the singing more enjoyable with larger numbers. It will need everyone to be willing to support the experiment and to travel beyond their parish boundary, despite perhaps being taken out of one's 'comfort zone'. **Nature Notes.** Two species of birds have turned up in the Parishes during June, in spite of the heavy rain and flooding. Firstly, a spotted flycatcher feeding on what insects were available in our garden and on 16<sup>th</sup>, a pair of yellow wagtails at the junction of Fryton Lane and the old railway track. Other sightings of this wagtail were along Green Dyke Lane, Slingsby, and Long Lane, as well as Gilling and Ampleforth. Maybe the yellow wagtail, a declining summer migrant, is now showing signs of recovery. So, along with the pied, we have had all three species of wagtail in the Parishes. MT 2.7.07. (628620)
