Nature Notes. Analysis of eight owl pellets, removed from the ground below our owl nesting box, showed that the barn owls had eaten common shrews, bank voles, field voles and a single brown rat. The analysis, carried out by members of the Yorkshire Mammal Group, also found the remains of what they thought was a claw of a baby owl. The box, we suspect, has one baby barn owl in it.
